Remaining Together

"I do not say this to condemn you, for I said before that you are in our hearts, to die together and to live together." (2 Corinthians 7:3)

"you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows up into a temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit." (Ephesians 2:19-22)

Renewing Together

"But God, who comforts the downcast, comforted us by the coming of Titus, and not only by his coming but also by the comfort with which he was comforted by you." (2 Corinthians 7:6-7)

Repenting Together

"I rejoice, not because you were grieved, but because you were grieved into repenting. . . For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret." (2 Corinthians 7:9-10)

Rejoicing Together

"besides our comfort, we rejoiced still more at the joy of Titus, because his spirit has been refreshed by you all." (2 Corinthians 7:13)

"If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together." (2 Corinthians 12:26)
